

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE EV EXPERIENCE CZECHIA EVENT

§ 1 General provisions

1. These terms and conditions pertain to the organization of the **EV Experience Czechia** event by the Polish Alternative Fuels Association (PSPA) ("**Organizer**") on 29/4/2024 at the Automotodrom Brno Circuit ("**Event**") and outline the rules for participation.
2. The Organizer of the Event is Polish Alternative Fuels Association (PSPA) with its registered office in Warszawa, at ul. Fabryczna 5A, 00-446 Warszawa, registered in the register of associations of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS (National Court Register Number): 0000643156, REGON (statistical number): 365877690, NIP (tax identification number): 5252684377 (PSPA).
3. The event is educational. The goal of the event is to examine electromobility in practice.
4. During the Event, at the stand prepared by the Organizer's partners, the participants will also be able to learn about electromobility, become familiar with the offering of the partners and participate in test drives conducted at the Brno Automotodrom Circuit.
5. These terms and conditions apply to all individuals present at the site of the Event during the Event.
6. Every participant in the Event is obligated to comply with these terms and conditions, and by choosing to take part in the Event, they accept these terms and conditions.
7. The purpose of the terms and conditions is to define the rules for participation in the Event, ensuring safety by specifying the behavior of individuals present during the Event and how they may utilize the site of the Event and its facilities.
8. The Organizer is the party responsible for the organization of the Event.
9. Safety at the stands of the exhibitors participating in the Event is the responsibility of the exhibitors/partners of the Organizer.

§ 2 Admittance to the Event

1. The Event is not open to the general public. Participation in the Event is restricted to individuals who have received an invitation and have confirmed their attendance. Only individuals meeting these criteria ("**Participants**") will be admitted to the Event.
2. Admittance to the Event is free.
3. Upon confirmation of attendance, the invitation to the Event entitles the Participant to unrestricted use of the attractions offered on the Event site. Participation in test drives organized by the Organizer is permitted if the Participant meets the requirements specified at the test drive site and complies with instructions from the Organizer or test drive personnel, as they are conducted on a queue system basis
4. To participate in the Event, the Participant must confirm attendance in response to the invitation by email by April 12, 2024, at kucerovm@visa.com
Following this confirmation, the Participant will receive the Terms and Conditions of EV Experience Czechia and the terms and conditions of Automotodrom Brno as well

as the rules for test drives – if the Participant is going to take part in the test drives – and will be entitled to arrive at the site of the Event. Upon arrival at the Event site and acknowledgment and acceptance of the aforementioned documents, a contract for participation in the Event ("Contract") will be signed with the Participant under the terms defined in the indicated documents.

5. Regardless of the above, by participating in the Event, the Participant agrees to adhere to the Terms and Conditions of EV Experience Czechia and the terms and conditions of the Automotodrom Brno Circuit, which must be signed by the Participant before entering the Event site.
6. By accepting the Terms and Conditions and participating in the Event, the Participant grants the Organizer the right to use, record, process, duplicate, and distribute the Participant's image captured in the form of a photograph or video recording without charge. The Participant also allows the Organizer to distribute the recorded image for informational, promotional, and advertising purposes related to the Event or operations of PSPA, including on PSPA profiles on social media platforms such as Facebook or LinkedIn. This consent applies even if the Participant's image is not part of the Event.

§ 3

Withdrawing from the Event

1. Every Participant may withdraw from the Event at any time by sending an e-mail to kucerovm@visa.com.

§ 4

Rules to be observed during the Event

1. Minors attending the Event must be accompanied by their legal guardians and are solely the responsibility of said guardians.
2. Participants in the Event and all individuals present at the Event site must conduct themselves in a manner that does not endanger others.
3. Participants in the Event must adhere to all instructions provided by Organizer representatives to ensure safety and order.
4. Prohibited actions include:
 1. Damaging signage, information signs, advertising media, devices, and equipment at the Event site.
 2. Engaging in any activity that may endanger the lives, health, or safety of individuals at the Event site, including throwing objects.
 3. Damaging lawns, shrubs, and trees at the Event site.
 4. Bringing firearms or other dangerous objects, explosives, fireworks, alcoholic beverages, flammable materials, narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances, sharp objects, etc., to the Event site or carrying them during the Event.
 5. Bringing pets.
 6. Participating in the Event under the influence of alcohol or narcotics.
5. In addition to these Terms and Conditions, Participants must comply with the rules in effect at the stands of Organizer partners (exhibitors) and the [Terms and Conditions of Automotodrom Brno](#).

6. Organizer representatives have the right to instruct individuals who disturb public order or violate the terms and conditions to leave the Event if they do not comply.
7. The Organizer may record the Event for documentation, promotion, or advertising for the Event and the Organizer, including sponsors and partners. Images of individuals present at the Event may be recorded and distributed for documentation, reporting, advertising, and promotion. By participating in the Event, participants consent to the recording and processing of their image.
8. The Organizer is not liable for the consequences of force majeure events. Force majeure events shall be construed as an event beyond the Organizer's control as a result of which the Organizer's obligations become impossible to be fulfilled or their fulfilment can be regarded as impossible due to the circumstances. Force majeure events include, in particular, weather conditions, failures or disruptions in the operation of equipment used to supply electricity, heat or light, state of epidemic emergency, etc.

§ 5

Personal data processing

1. The controller of the personal data of the participants in the Event is the Polish Alternative Fuels Association (PSPA) ("Controller").
2. The Controller collects and processes the personal data of the participants in the Event, including, in particular, the first name, last name, e-mail address, and other information provided at the time of registration for the Event.
3. The personal data are processed for the following purposes:
 - a) pursuing a legitimate interest of the Controller, i.e., to organize the Event, ensure security, conduct administrative activities, and prepare a photo report on the event (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR);
 - b) performing the contract for participation in the Event (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR);
 - c) purposes arising from the consent of the participant (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR);
 - d) fulfilment of the legal obligations connected with the organization of the Event (Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR).
4. Personal data may be provided to parties that will process the personal data of the participant for the Controller in connection with services provided for the Controller (e.g., providers of IT or security services) and other parties competent under the law.
5. Personal data will be kept for as long as they are useful for the processing purposes indicated in paragraph 3 above. The data will not be subject to profiling.
6. Every person has the following rights:
 - a) right to access the data,
 - b) right to rectify the data,
 - c) right to data portability,
 - d) right to data erasure,
 - e) right to restriction of processing,
 - f) right to object to data processing,
 - g) right to withdraw the consent without affecting the lawfulness of processing,
 - h) the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
7. Providing the data is voluntary, but attending the Event will not be possible if they are not provided.
